RE: AP Exams – please read the entire letter

Dear Parents,

The purpose of this communication is to provide information about the 2018 AP Exams and the AP testing schedule. In addition to the information provided to you by teachers and administrators, please note that all information about the AP Exams can be accessed on-line at www.collegeboard.com.

Any student planning to take an exam is expected to fill out the enclosed AP Exam form and return it with payment (cash, check or credit/debit card) to the OCHS Accounting Office NO LATER than March 20, 2018 at 3:30pm. Exams will be ordered immediately and NO late requests for orders will be accepted.

All students taking an AP Exam are required to attend the pre-administration session in each of their AP classes to be announced by their individual AP teachers. Students who qualify for the Federal Free & Reduced Lunch Program **must** self-identify by checking the appropriate box on the form. The cost for each exam is **\$68.00**. If a student is currently enrolled in the Federal Free & Reduced Lunch Program their fee will be covered by a grant through the Oregon Department of Education if they self-identify on the AP Exam Form to be returned to the OCHS Accounting Office.

The AP Bulletin for students and parents is available on-line, and a copy will be distributed to students by their AP teachers. **Please check with your student to make certain they understand what they may and may not bring to the exam room and exam protocols.** This is a time to leave cell phones and electronic listening and communication devices at home!

OCHS students have done very well on the AP Exams and we encourage all AP students to take the exams. AP Exam scores will be available **on-line only** to students in July 2018. Students may choose the college or universities that should receive copies of their scores.
