Use you Spanish to order at a Mexican restaurant.

Watch a movie (turn on the Spanish language track)

Go to a Mexican or international market, ask for help in Spanish

Talk with your friends (who know/speak some Spanish)

Watch a program or sporting event on Univisión (comcast channel 47-1)

Read the news online in Spanish

Go to the school district website and find the "Tumblebooks" link (under student research) and read some books!
