

AP Statistics Summer Homework: 2018-2019

Welcome to AP Statistics! In this course you will be asked to critically think and analyze data about multiple topics. You will never have to ask the questions “how is this used in real life?” because everything we do in this course will help you understand the world around you. You will come away with a better understanding of polling data and what it really means when someone gives you an average. You will understand how people use graphics to mislead you and how to ask questions to not be misled. In the end you will also understand how to determine if the samples and experiments you are evaluating actually mean there is a difference or association between different ideas/variables.

The summer homework for this course has 2 parts.

Part I: Logistics

Get signed up on Google Classroom and get used to using it as a means for communicating with each other and turning some work in.

Sign up for Remind 101

Understand the syllabus and requirements of the course

Make sure you have the necessary supplies for the course for the first day (we will be using calculators regularly and you will NEED one to be successful in this course)

Part II: Review

I will have you review material and content that you have learned in previous courses so I can assess how much time we will need to spend reviewing in class. You will also get used to some of the functionality of your calculators as you do this.
