

Dodgeball Rules

1. 6 player on the court at a time, 8 players per team.
2. 6 balls per court.
3. Crossing the middle line will result in a player being out of the game.
4. Game will be 12 minutes. Team with the most players will win **or** if all players are out on one team the game is over. If at the end of the 12 minute game both teams have the same amount of players, the players will play a sudden death match. First team to eliminate a player from the other team wins the match!
5. Catching the ball will allow a teammate back in and the thrower of the ball will be out.
6. Teams must have a school appropriate theme/ team name.
7. If the dodgeball bounces off a teammate and is caught by a teammate it counts as rule number 5.
8. There will be no overturning (or arguing) of calls. The referee has final call.
9. Dodgeballs that leave the boundary can be retrieved by out player or active players if dodgeballs are on your side of the court.
10. Championship match will be best 2 out of 3 rounds.
