FORECASTING INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION

Forecasting sheets are due Wednesday, March 8th, 2017

Please follow these instructions carefully and make sure you forecast for the appropriate classes to meet your graduation requirements and to prepare you for your post-high school plans.

1. Make sure you have a Curriculum Handbook, Graduation Requirement Profile Sheet, and online forecasting instructions.
2. Your Curriculum Handbook (pg. 5-12) and profile sheet will be helpful for course planning.
3. Check pre-requisites and courses that require teacher recommendation. If you forecast for a class in which you do not meet the pre-requisites or do not have required signatures you will **NOT** be placed in the class.
4. Obtain teachers, parent and advisory teacher signatures where required before returning your forecast sheet to your advisory teacher.
5. Carefully choose **6** alternate elective classes in case a first choice elective is unavailable.
 - Some elective classes may not be taught due to under-enrollment; others will have more students sign up than space available; and others may not fit into a student's schedule due to a conflict.
 - If you do not provide sufficient alternate electives, you will be scheduled into an open class that you did not choose.
6. **Students should be extremely careful when choosing classes, even the alternatives classes, because class changes will not be allowed unless there is an error/conflict.**
7. Forecasting help will be available during lunch March 2nd- March 7th in the Front Lobby.
8. Forecast sheets must be completed **before** advisory class on Wednesday, March 8th.
9. Online Forecasting will be completed **during** advisory on Wednesday, March 8th.

Students who do not turn in a forecast sheet will have a sheet completed for them by their counselor.
