The members of the OREGON CITY Student Council take their jobs very seriously. As campus leaders, we set and maintain a series of standards that we believe to be representative of today's youthful leaders. Each member is asked to sign this contract. By signing, you are agreeing to abide by these standards at school and away from school.

I am committed to do my share of the work and keep my commitments. This includes attending class and activities. I must maintain at least 90% attendance in order to represent my classmates. I will only miss class when it is unavoidable.

I understand a portion of my grade will be based on completion of Student Council and Community Service hours out of class.

I understand that if I cannot attend class or a scheduled event that I will notify the advisor and my committee head prior to the event.

I will read and understand the Constitution of this organization and follow it to the best of my abilities.

I will not say or do anything that could reflect negatively on the OCHS student council or student council activities.

I will use my student privileges wisely.

I will fulfill the duties of my office by being punctual with paperwork, keeping open communications with my committee, checking my mailbox on a daily basis, and keeping the student body I represent informed on upcoming events and issues.

I will honor the Council Duties Contract that outlines all the duties and responsibilities that come with my position on the Council.

I understand and accept that if my personal conduct is unbecoming of a student leader, that I will be removed from Student Council. This includes poor grades, truancies, excessive tardiness, fighting, the use of firearms, drugs or alcohol, misuse of social media, cheating, stealing, time spent in ISS or OSS, after school detention, teacher detentions, disrespect to faculty and administration at school or in relation to any school activity.

I am a liaison between the student body and the administration, and I will work to create activities through communication and consideration. (Seek first to understand)

I understand that violating my Oath of Office or not completing Council Duties can result in removal from office.

I understand that I will be expected to work on improving as a leader by focusing on specific standards.
