Oregon City High School uses the Senior Project independent class as a way for students to complete graduation requirements in the area of Personalized Learning and College\Career Readiness. Personalized Learning involves an OCHS Senior student completing activities related to one of two options. The options include the following:

**Option #1 – Senior Project**

Student develops, designs, implements, and documents a project related to a future career goal or interest. The project involves the student working actively with a mentor to assist them in completing and verifying that the student has completed a project. The activities relate to the Senior Project standards of personal management, problem solving, communication, and teamwork. The student must be self-motivated and stay on task to be successful.

**Option #2 - College and Career Readiness Activities**

There are 8 activities that help prepare the student for life after OCHS whether they go into college or career. The activities are staggered over the trimester and involve the student doing activities that related to personal management and communication.

**As Senior Project is a graduation requirement at Oregon City High School**, it is required that each senior student complete the course requirements in order to graduate. Students taking Senior Project during the spring trimester understand that they must complete all of the requirements of the Senior Project course on or before the due dates for each option. Students will be allowed ONE late assignment for OPTION #2 ONLY and can still earn an A grade for the trimester. No late assignments are allowed for option #1. After one late assignment, the student is reduced in grade to a C. All assignments must be turned and completed fully for a student to pass the course with a C or higher. All assignment details and documents can be found at high school web site front page at the bottom, under SENIORS, you will find SENIOR PROJCT.

It is further understood that **ANY late work** for Senior Project must be turned in no later than March 7, 2018, by 3:30 PM if the student plans to pass for Winter Trimester. Students not meeting the Senior Project graduation requirement winter trimester will be re-enrolled into SPRING Trimester to re-do the Senior Project requirements again.

Parents and students acknowledge that Senior Project is a requirement for graduation and that you have agreed to work with your student to complete all course assignments by the due dates or turn in any late work by March 7, 2018 by 3:30 PM.
