FORECASTING INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION

(Class of 2022—Current 8TH Grade Students)

Today, you will begin forecasting for your first year of high school! Although you have some required courses, you will have the opportunity to choose certain classes and electives.

Please follow these instructions carefully and make sure you forecast for the appropriate classes to meet your graduation requirements and prepare you for your post-high school plans.

1. Make sure you have a Curriculum Handbook to help you make your course selections.
2. When choosing classes, **check prerequisites** and courses that require teacher recommendation as indicated in the Curriculum Handbook. Please obtain teacher signatures where requested.
3. Be sure to closely read the course descriptions before selecting classes. The classes you forecast for will be the classes you are placed into. **Schedule changes will only be allowed to resolve conflicts and fix errors.**
4. Carefully choose **Six** alternate elective classes in case a first choice elective is unavailable.
 - Some elective classes may not be taught due to under-enrollment; others will have more students sign up than space available; and others may not fit into a student's schedule due to a conflict.
 - If you do not provide sufficient alternate electives, you will be scheduled into an open class.
5. If you are interested in Yearbook or AVID, applications need to be filled out and turned in with your forecast sheet. Please forecast as if you were **not** accepted into the class. You will be added into the classes upon acceptance at a later date.
6. Once your paper forecast sheet is complete, login to your Student Vue account and enter your class choices under course requests. See the online forecasting instructions online at www.ochspioneers.org/counseling/forecasting for help.
7. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PARENT REVIEW YOUR CHOICES AND SIGN YOUR SHEET.**
8. Students who do not submit a forecast sheet will have a sheet completed for them by their counselor
